Here are some of the bills that were signed into law by the Governor:

AB 298 Honoring Our Blind Veterans.

AB 988 Miles Hall Lifeline and Suicide Prevention Act: Designates the 3-digit telephone number “988” as the universal number within the United States for the purpose of the national suicide prevention and mental health crisis hotline system operating through the 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline .

AB 1745 Public postsecondary education: veterans: waiver of mandatory systemwide tuition and fees.
