All these programs are on the Americanism Mid-year Report. Each Unit has time to complete one or more of these tasks so the Unit can have something to put in their Mid-year report.

AUXILIARY EMERGENCY FUND DIANA LIVAS

Who is eligible for AEF? If you are an Auxiliary member for 2 years and are in good standing you qualify for AEF. This program gives assistance from financial setbacks due to unexpected events. When no other source of aid is readily available to pay for shelter, basic household utilities and/or loss of income. AEF might be of some assistance. Applicants must have exhausted all other financial options and be able to provide past due bills.

The Process:

Unit - Start at your Unit, all the information provided is private, no names are given to the general membership. If necessary, your application can be forwarded to the District, who will review and determine the necessary amount to give (depending on the funds in account).

District – Will review the application and determine assistance to the member.

What qualifies as an emergency all depends on your situation. This is why it is important to start the process with your Unit.
