Planning on going to convention? Fees MUST be paid regardless of whether any delegates or alternates from your Unit are attending. Delegates in Their Own Right, Fees must be paid by their Unit. District President, Department Chairpersons, Past Department Presidents, Members of Department Finance, Girls State Director, Junior Conference Director, Hospital Representatives, Past National President, and Appointed Department Chairpersons.






BEWARE OF SCAMS & PHISHING
